In exercise of the powers conferred by Rule 7 of the Homoeopathy Central Council (Election) Rules, 1975, the Returning Officer appointed by the Central Government under clause (d) of rule 2 of the said rules for the conduct of election to the Homoeopathy Central Council under clause (a) of sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 (59 of 1973) to conduct the election of two members from persons enrolled on the State Register of Homoeopathy, hereby publish the dates for the purpose noted against each as hereunder:

- (a) Receipt of Nomination paper .. Before 4.00 p.m. on Monday the 18th February, 2013 at the Office of the Returning Officer, Travancore-Cochin Medical Councils, Combined Council Building, Red Cross Road, Thiruvananthapuram-35.
- (b) Scrutiny of Nomination paper .. 11.00 a.m. on Tuesday the 19th February, 2013 at the Office of the Returning Officer, Travancore-Cochin Medical Councils Combined Council Building, Red Cross Road, Thiruvananthapuram-35.
- (c) Withdrawal of Nomination paper .. Before 4.00 p.m. on Tuesday the 26th February, 2013 at the Office of the Returning Officer, Travancore-Cochin Medical Councils, Combined Council Building, Red Cross Road, Thiruvananthapuram-35.
- (d) Despatch of voting paper to electors .. Before 4.00 p.m. on Friday the 12th April, 2013.
- (e) The Poll .. Before 5.00 p.m. on Monday the 13th May, 2013 at the Office of the Returning Officer, Travancore-Cochin Medical Councils, Combined Council Building, Red Cross Road, Thiruvananthapuram- 35.
- (f) Opening of the Outer envelope .. After 5.00 p.m. on Monday the 13th May, 2013.
- (g) Scrutiny and counting of votes .. At 10.00 a.m. on Wednesday the 15th May, 2013.

**General Instructions**

1. Every candidate for election shall be nominated by means of a nomination paper in the prescribed form which will be supplied free of cost by Returning Officer to any elector applying for it.
2. Every nomination paper shall be signed by two electors as proposer and seconder and shall contain a declaration signed by the person proposed signifying his consent to stand for the election. The nomination paper may be submitted to the Returning Officer, Office of the Returning Officer, Travancore-Cochin Medical Councils, Combined Council Building, Red Cross Road, Thiruvananthapuram-35 either personally or by registered post.
3. No elector as proposer or seconder shall sign more than one nomination paper.
4. Any candidate can be nominated by more than one nomination paper for the same election but not more than 4 nomination paper on behalf of any candidate will be accepted by the Returning Officer.
5. Nomination paper received after the time and date specified will be rejected.
6. The nomination paper will be taken up for scrutiny at the date and time specified. On that day and time the candidates proposer and the seconder of each candidate may attend the Office of the Returning Officer to examine the nomination papers of all candidates.
7. Any candidate may withdraw his candidature within seven days after scrutiny of nomination papers by notice in writing signed by him and delivered to Returning Officer, Central Council of Homoeopathy Election, Travancore-Cochin Medical Councils, Red Cross Road, Thiruvananthapuram-35 on or before the date and time specified.
8. Cancellation of withdrawal will not be permitted.
9. The voting paper and other connected papers will be sent to all electors by registered post.

10. Every voter desirous of voting may personally deliver or send by post his/her ballot paper in accordance with the direction contained in Form IV after recording his/her vote in the prescribed manner so as to reach the Returning Officer, Central Council of Homoeopathy Election, Officer of the Registrar, Travancore-Cochin Medical Councils, Red Cross Road, Thiruvananthapuram-35 on or before the date and time specified.
11. Any candidate may be present in person or may send a representative duly authorized by him in writing to attend at the time, the outer envelopes are opened and of scrutiny and counting of votes.
