Kerala has recently experienced the worst natural calamity of floods, and there is every possibility of outbreaks of epidemics due to the logging of contaminated water in the houses and premises of the houses.

And whereas, a report has been submitted by the District Medical Officer, Thiruvananthapuram that there is a need to be more vigilant on possible communicable disease outbreaks and it is very important that any such case must be identified instantly and responded appropriately and it is necessary to collect the reports regarding communicable diseases from all Government hospitals, private hospitals and private practitioners and also request to issue necessary orders in this regard.

Now therefore, I Dr. K. Vasuki IAS the District Collector & Chairman, District Disaster Management Authority, do hereby invoke the powers conferred upon me under section 55 & 56 of Disaster Management Act 2005 and order that all Medical Institutions including Government Medical Colleges, Government Hospitals and dispensaries, Private Medical Colleges, Private Hospitals and Private Practitioners are directed to report any case which is consulted and treated by them and which fit in to the case definition of diseases or syndromes mentioned in the prescribed proforma annexed herewith on daily basis before 2 pm to the District Medical Officer or the officials nominated by the DMO. And it is further ordered to post a Nodal Officer or reporting official in every institution who be identified and entrusted with

this responsibility and coordinate the reporting process and report the name of such officer to the DMO today itself.

It is further clarified that the non compliance of the order either by omission or otherwise will attract penal provisions envisaged u/s 51, 54, 55, 56, 57, and 58 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005.


